

Still existed 1831 *

The area indicated as being the site of a barrow falls mainly in the NE corner of a large pasture field belonging to Mr Morgan, Joetewan. He said that this area had been dug out many years ago to make a watering hole. There is still a small pond here but the area is also used now as a dumping ground. A track leads down to the bottom. There is a small mound 8m long NW \rightarrow SE direction, 1.7m high on the west side next to the hedge.

The area is overgrown with trees & blackthorn.

The area to the east is a narrow water-filled hollow, and to the north pasture, on a slight hillside.
