& COMMENT **AUTHORITY** 84 No. 3 Jeffreston St. Oswald's Church 3478 This church was restored in 1868. There is a good arcade between the nave and north aisle, with three pointed arches and slender rounded pillars with round bases. A very small south transept with a flat - arch. From this transept a low round arch, about 5 feet high and 9 \_ feet wide, leads into a little southern chapel. Facing this chapel on the northern side is a recess, with a very large squint. This church is the burial place of the Allens of Cresselly. Here too is - a memorial to R. Edwards of Cresswell and Margaret his wife - 1794.  $\_$  Good font with scalloped edge. The cross in the yard was restored on an old stump.
