This is in a position of great natural strength above the East Cleddau, which runs at the south. It is roughly in a triangular form. There is a large double mound, each about 11 feet high on the north. On the west (where is part of Drim Wood) and on the south and east there is a steep declivity. The camp is much overgrown. The length is about 150 yards from north to south, and in the widest part, from east to west, about 60 yards. The plateau comes to a point on the south.
