New House, Canaston

Ruined Mansion 3621

Nothing is really known as to the history of this house. The basement, used perhaps as a kitchen, is 15 yards by 10 yards; a fireplace to the east stair on south-west; window west; three windows north; door and loophole to south. The hall had two chimneys on east; two windows south; stair south-west; window west; window north-west; window north; window north-east corner. A portion of the building at east end is cut off by a dividing wall, which seems later work. On east of basement is a door in ruined wall; on the south a window cut off by the dividing wall; west blank; south a low window. Above the east is gone; west blank wall; north window; south a big window and loop. A moat runs round the building and there is a square stew or fish-pond. See Fenton, 302.
