THE WETHERS' CASTLE seems to indicate that this camp has at some time been used to fold sheep. It is nearly a parallelogram, with rounded corners, and was surrounded by a single foss and vallum. The work is greatly obliterated, only one end being perfect. It is thought by some persons to show indications of Roman work. See Owen's Pembrokeshire, I, 320. Arch. Camb. II, ii, 325.
