

Described by Cantill + Jones ① as 'scanty remains' of a 'prehistoric hearth' on the east side of a pond 300 yds west of Blaengors Farm. This description is ~~also~~ copied in ②. The OS ③ failed to find the site.

The field is under pasture for cattle + was ploughed some 3-4 years ago - info. from the daughter of the family - her mother. She said remembered archaeologists ^{- the OS?} calling some 10-15 years ago so when they ploughed they kept a look out for anything of interest. The field is very undulating with ridges and hollows running NE to SW to join the stream in the next field west. There is no trace of the pond or of the 'prehistoric hearth' mentioned in ①
