

Hillfort as described by OS in 1915. Hedgebanks on ramparts overgrown but show no signs of animal erosion or other interference. Eastern curved bank is best viewed from the east side from which it stands to a height of 0.9m. A possible second bank is visible to the SE, outside the curved bank. The width of the clearer bank is 12m - spread probably due to ploughing.

Grass in the interior of the hillfort was rather high and no features of hut circles were discernible.

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
