

Visited 14/7/82. The area to the immediate NW of the site has been stripped and lowered, & a ~~hard~~ ^{hard-core} layer is being dumped - the area affected is c. 25 x 35 m. A cut has been made through the rampart in the NW corner, and soil has been spread across the whole of the area of Ward's building. A piece of possibly Roman tile was found & discarded.
