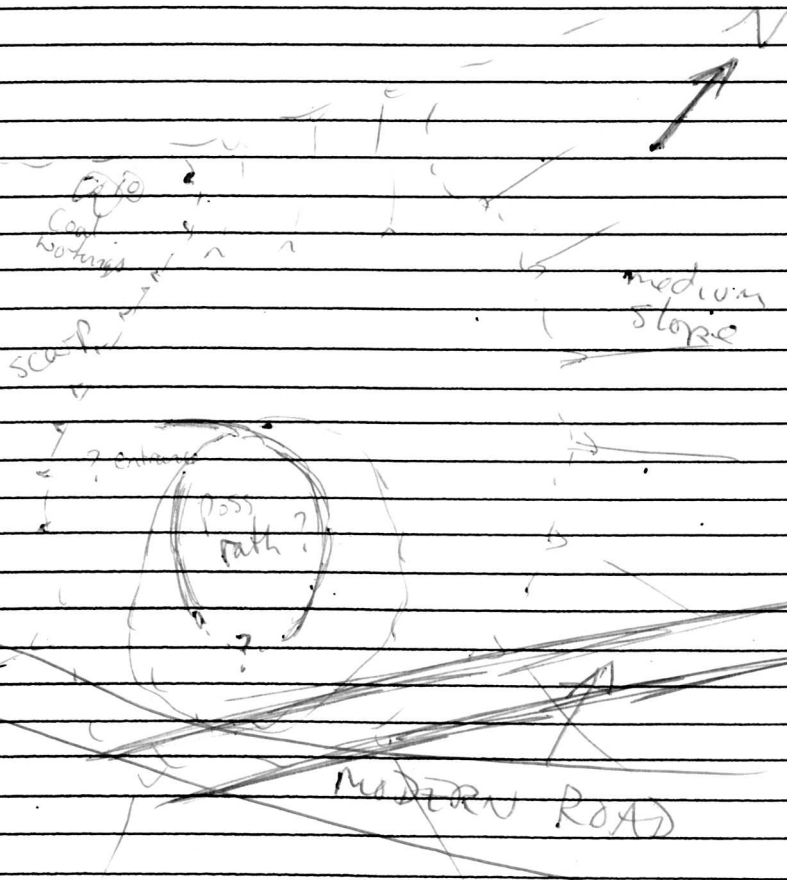
5] Possible rath site on promontory overlooking the valley to S + E. Slight undulations may define ploughed out defensive works - but no definite plans discerned.

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High probability that this site was a promontory fort due to its commanding view, and good defensible position

Note especially a natural scarp along the S side of the promontory which offers good protection. The hillock is detached from the main hill to the NW and only connected by a narrow, lower neck of land

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Upon closer examination the 'rath' was seen to include low, denuded banks on SW + NW sides. SE side may be disturbed and precise bank line not obvious. An entrance may exist at NW corner. Measured at c. 70m NW-SE x 50m NE-SW - overall dimensions. Needs AP investigation.
