The OS (1) have recorded that the 1909 excavation by Treherne + Robinson and the 1921 excavation by Congreve + Gordon-Williams were conducted on the same tumulus PRN 3912. However a reading of the excavation reports (2)(3) show that this is in error and that the earlier excavation (1909) (2) was conducted on the tumulus PRN 3912 and the later (1921) (3) was conducted on the tumulus PRN 3913.
