The OS ① have recorded the 1909 excavation by Treherne + Robinson and the 1921 excavation by Congreve + Gordon-Williams as being conducted on the same Tumulus PRN 3912. The round barrow is situated in the middle of a pasture field used for grazing cattle. It has been much spread by ploughing although Mr Jenkins Jr answered us that it had 'only been ploughed once' in the last few years'.
