

The enclosure is situated on a gentle east facing hill slope at the east side of a large pasture field. Seen as a rectangular single banked enclosure 63×32 m, best preserved on the west side where it measures 0.3 m high externally and 0.7 m high internally. The east bank shows as a slight ground swelling. The north and south banks are up to 0.3 m high, and continue faintly further east down towards the hedgeline. The interior is featureless.

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
