Nothing is known of this little chapel. The eastern gable stands about 16 feet high, and in it is a round-headed splayed window, underneath which are the remains of a masonry altar; on the south side is what may have been a piscina, and on the north an aumbry. The door was on the northern side; the stone in which the pin of it revolved still remains. The west wall is gone. There seems to have been a step or two down into the chapel. A well is hard by.
