Raised beach and disused Roads

Here a good specimen of raised beach is exposed. Leading to it are two disused roads, which have been carefully made, as the surface has been levelled and the rock cut through. At present they end in a sheer drop of some 20 feet over the raised beach onto the rocks below. Perhaps when they were constructed, the raised beach was covered by debris and so gave passage for carts, etc. to St. Margaret's at low water; if so the bank has been washed away.
