A horse-shoe shaped earthwork, defended by a single fosse and vallum. The fosse is 6 feet deep; the vallum 12 feet to 14 feet high. The west side looked over the steep bank of a narrow deep ravine, with a stream at the bottom. The heel of the shoe is 116 yards across at present; but the sides of the camp project beyond the modern enclosing fence.
