1806. Renovated 1862. Worked until 1906 when wings were dismantled.

A field here bears the name PARC Y FELYN, where there was a windmill all trace of which has now disappeared.		
Early to mid 19th. Former mill house. Two storeys. Colourwashed stone rubble walls. Cemented slate gabled roof. Higher wing to south-east; garden elevation with a sash window three panes wide and four panes deep both on first floor and below; cellar opening with cambered head. Wing to north-west with lower eaves and ridge. Cemented roof. Two flat sash dormers with gabled heads. Stack to left hand. On first floor, two sash windows with glazing bars and with their heads at eaves level. On ground floor, a large three-light modern metal-framed casement to each side of central flat-headed doorway with modern door. Sash windows with glazing bars in road elevation.		BSATH - St David's
