At this spot, Henry Earl of Richmond is said to have landed August 1st 1485. In Old Pembrokeshire Parishes John Brown, the author, states that "the Earl landed just outside Milford Haven", but I (Henry Mathias) have always understood that the Earl rounded St. Anne's Head, brought up in Mill Bay, and landed on the beach at a spot marked on the Ordnance map Harry's Cart House, the site of an old mill, where the stream of water dividing the farms of Snailton and Brunt empties into the sea.
