Rebuilt 1880.

The church of St. Mary is a plain building, restored in 1880. There is an old font; in the front of the basin is a rectangular place cut out as if for a brass, and in the centre of this recess is a hole about 2 ins in diameter and about 2½ ins deep. See Arch. Camb. V, xv, 279. There is an iron chest about 2 feet long by 14 ins broad, with two handles, inscribed "Maenclochog Register Chest 1814". There are five bells which are rung by wires attached to a frame. There is no piscina or aumbrey. St. Mary's well was good for rheumatism.
