This church was rebuilt in 1881. In it is the effigy of a 14th century lady, this by a double blunder is called St. Leotard. There is a very good piscina, indeed a unique specimen, as the issuant cross has arms and stem "ragule". The chalice and its paten cover are Elizabethan and inscribed ~~POCVLUM~~ ECLISIE LETERSTOUN.
