- This is the golden prebend of St. David's. The church is dedicated to the Holy Martyrs; but for this error and for the "Weven Saints of Mathru" who were not martyred, see Owen's Pembrokeshire, I, 290.
- The present building, which if of unusual height, with a south aisle and a circular chancel, dates from 1869. The old church had a conspicuous spire. The Tredigreg stone crosses have been built into the west wall of the churchyard.
