

Built 1697, Rebuilt 1724, 1777, 1830.

A plaque on the front of the building states that it was built in 1830 and rebuilt in 1927.

The building is rectangular in shape and 2-storey. There are two large doors at the east end and a large flight of steps to the upper floor on the north side. The sundial base and stand* could not be seen although Mrs Nicholas (the caretaker) had remembered mention being made of it standing to the north of the building near to the water pump.

*Sundial = stand mentioned by RCAHM in 1913

The cemetery is large, the earliest gravestone visible dated back to 1708.
