As to the Welsh dedication of this Church there is a difficulty who was Erw or Wrw? - or is it only the word ERW - a slang of land? Lewis in his Topographical Dictionary, not only asserts that there was a Saint called Eirw, but states that in the days of Elizabeth, a choiristy chapel in the churchyard contained his tomb. In the porch, inscribed on a stone that has been removed from some other position, is the following legeng: JACOB PICTON
