In TCASFC^② a small circular flint scraper is mentioned as having been found in 1915 and the source is given as the above^①. However, the reference is given as having been found on Grist Point and donated to the Museum in 1922 which does not tie in with RCATHM^①

As TCASFC^② quote RCATHM^① as the source then presumably they are wrong in giving the provenance as Grist Point. There is also some confusion as to the date of donation
