

The field name 'Stone Park' was picked up from the Tithe Map + Apport ①. The field lies on a steep south-facing slope ② as shown on the map ②. The aerial photographs ③ show that this field is heavily wooded

The field lies on the farm of Castle Lloyd, on a steep south-facing wooded slope. Mr. Owen knew nothing about the name and could only suggest that the name came from the rock being very close to the surface on this slope.
