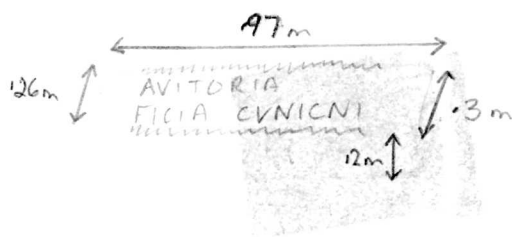


The grey inscribed stone is stored in a padlocked chest beside the vestry. Although used as a step for many years the latin and ogham inscriptions are well preserved and quite legible.

The latin inscription is on the flat face of the stone with the ogham inscriptions on the 2 edges of the face.

The stone measures -
