Castell Aves Taf is a good example of a motte and bailey. The motte is 5m high with a summit diameter of ~2.6m which has a saucer shaped depression of 0.9m. The motte is overgrown with brambles and some trees.

There is a short stretch of bank 17m long, 1m high situated about 8m away to the NWest side of the motte.

There is a ditch 2m deep and 4m wide on the east side of the motte; some rubbish has been dumped at the south end.

The bailey is elevated above ground level with scaped sides and is roughly rectangular in shape. It is overgrown with scrub.

The site is fenced off and appears to be uncultivated.
