DWR CLEIFION - Jones & Freeman, p. 40-6, quoting Archdeacon Payne, state their belief that the depression of the ground on the north east of the stream is a part of Ffos y Myneich. The writer believes that the Dyke took its course from the Bench Mark 218.3 in almost a straight line to Pont-y-Ddowrog, and that the depression is a part of Via Julia. This supposition is strengthened by the fact that near the Bench Mark referred to the roadway is lower than the fields on either side, and that this depression is characteristic of Via Julia at various points on its eastward course - at Middle Mill, near Whitland, and near Newport, in Monmouthshire, as well as at intervening points.
