6. Blaen Caerddwr (fig. 6; surveyed 1978) SN 75 NE

A small severely denuded cairn lying at c. 427 m OD by the side of a track on the end of a spur near the bottom of a small broad valley. The still visible perimeter of the mound measures 7 m (N-S) \times 5.5 m. The most prominent features of the site are four large orthostatic slabs around the edge of the cairn (the most massive on the S) and, at the centre, a rifled pistol.
