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A small severely denuded cairn lying at c. 427 m OD by the side of a track on the end of a spur near the bottom of a small broad valley. The still visible perimeter of the mound measures 7 m (N-S) $\times$ 5.5 m. The most prominent features of the site are four large orthostatic slabs around the edge of the cairn (the most massive on the S) and, at the centre, a rifled cist
