

Possible hillfort situated on a promontary west of the farmstead.

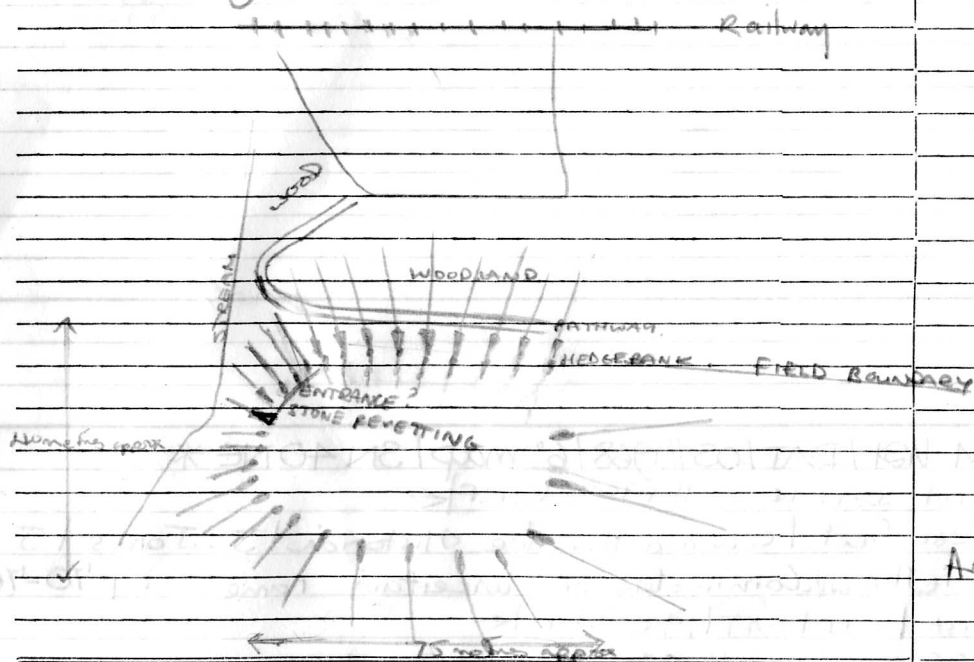
"a small promontory fort existed on field No 237 called Y Banc. A deep ditch has been drawn across the narrow point of a rock projection overlooking a ravine."

According to the fine schedule this held
was called 'craft'. No 1086.

The field has been ploughed, and the features of the hillfort on the SE have been mostly ploughed-out.

NW slope fairly steep. N slope gradually levels off to E. On E side is fairly level with a slight depression. Inside slight hollow, the hedgeback now recently been removed and the ditch on this side filled in.

Entrance on W side? with stone
swelling. Depth approx 2 1/2 m
