

Fenton considered this and other cliff castles the work of Danish pirates. Since his time it has been proved beyond doubt that they are of Neolithic origin, though subsequently they may have been used by later races. (E.L.)

A cable trench passed immediately to the north of this fort in 1993. Nothing of interest was noted in the trench, ie. There were no ditches to indicate an annexe to the fort or defended track. A buried soil was noted below below a defensive bank where erosion has occurred on the cliff edge.
