The Castle of Lle Gareig is noted by Leland^①
as standing upon a hill between the two
Gwendraeth Rivers. Lloyd^② includes it in
his discussion of mottes and places
it at Castell y Garreg. On this farm
the RCAHM^③ note the field name
Caer Castell.
