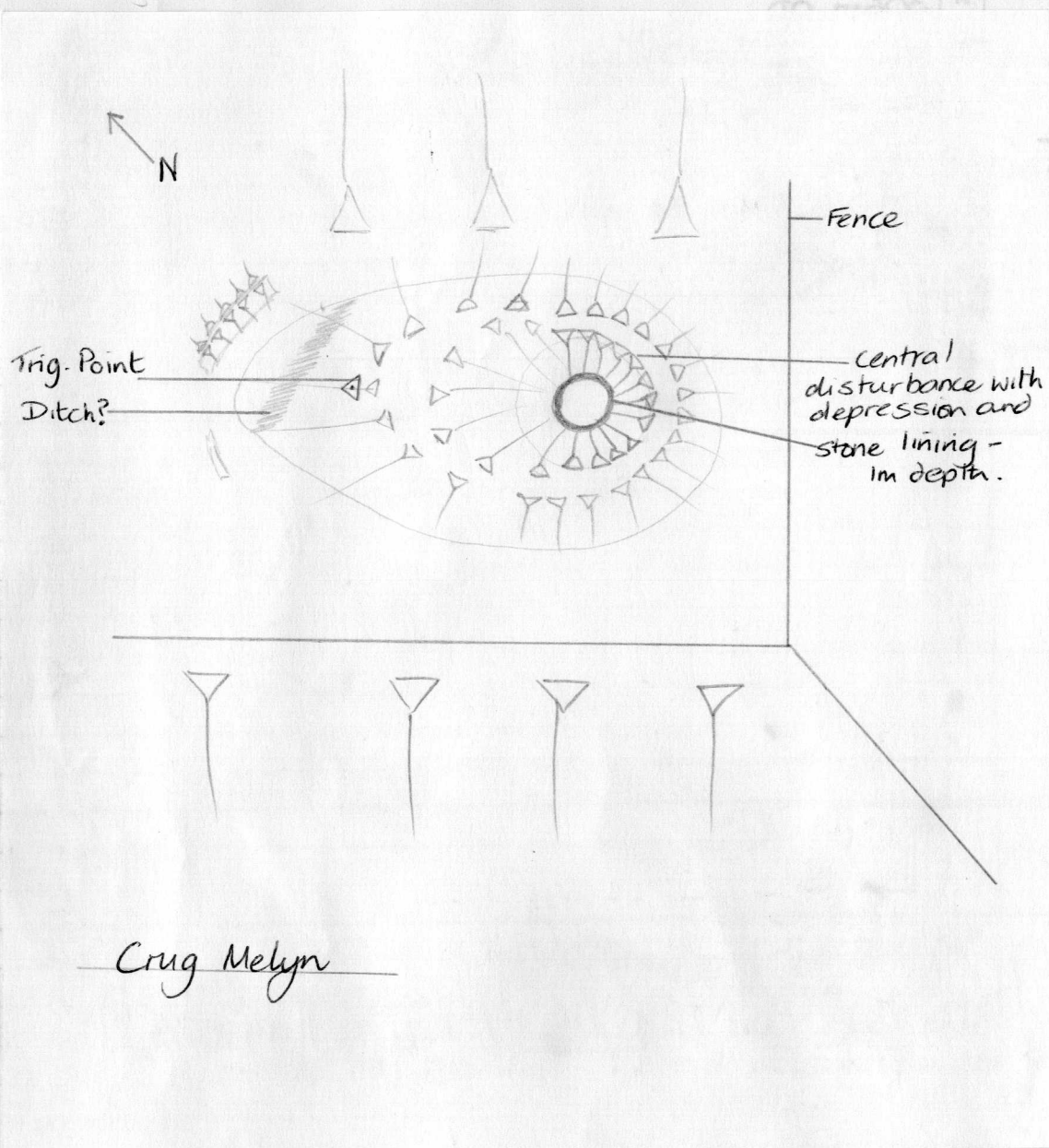


Crug Melyn exists to a height of approx  $1\frac{1}{2}$  m. Much mutilation has occurred to the centre of the barrow where a lining of stone is visible - probably dating from the second W.W. when Crug Melyn was used as a look out post.

A trig. point has been placed on top of the barrow. On the southern side an animal scrape reveals Crug Melyn's earth and stone construction: No other animal erosion has occurred.

There appears to be a ditch on the NW side.
