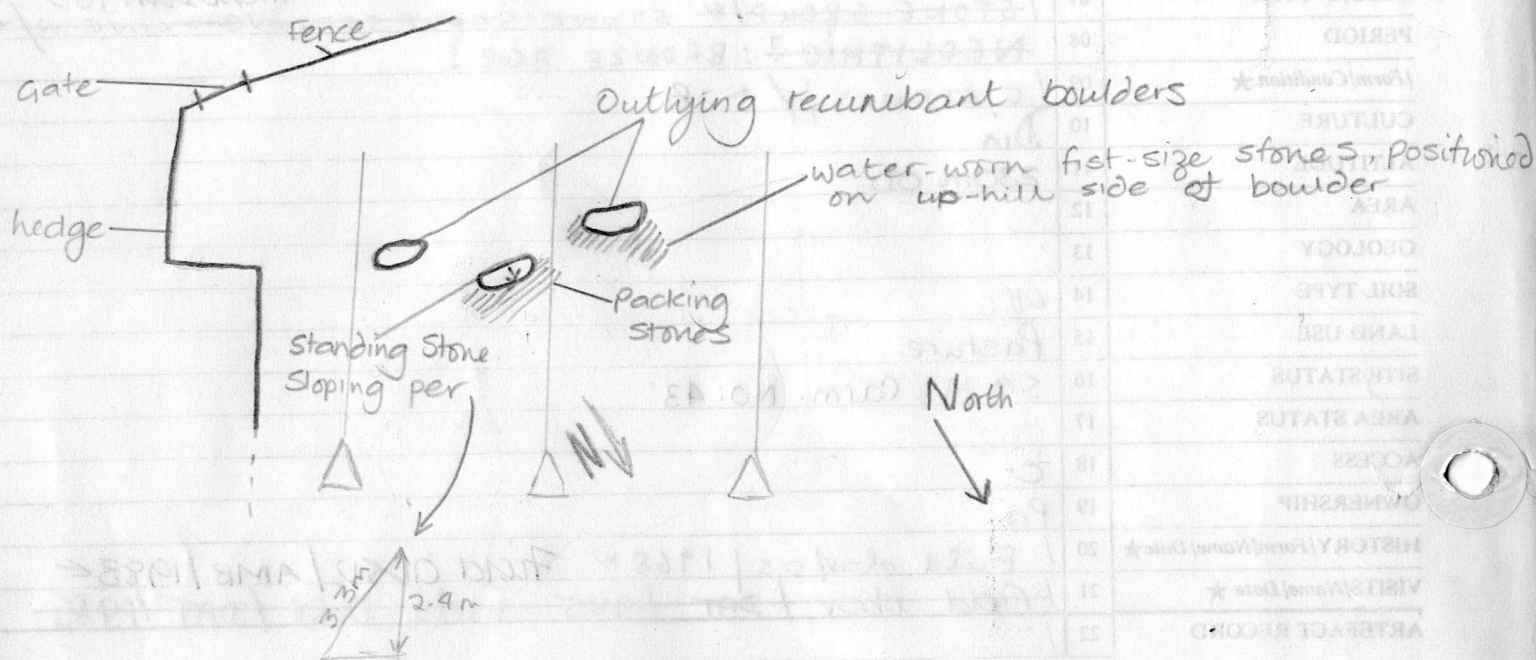




Group of three white quartz megaliths, arranged as in sketch. The Middle stone is leaning at 47° to $N15^\circ E$. The site is c. $\frac{1}{2}$ way down a long c. 1:20 pasture slope, on the side of the Golden Valley. Mr Powell, the owner, expressed concern about the lean, he claims that the stone was vertical 15 or 20 years ago (?) and has got a lot worse recently (?). There is a conflicting report by S. Rees in Carmus S.A.M. which states that the lean of the stone has been the same for fifty years.
