PCATHM 1976

The earliest house was built ~1500, 2 rooms down, 2 rooms up.

The manor house was built on to it c1740, this was a 2 storey building. It was extended c1840 and the roof raised to make it a 3 storey house with 21 rooms. There is a semicircular (lunette) window in the 3rd floor.

The earliest house became the farmhouse for the home farm: extensions to the back made it an 11 room house. It has a double roof.

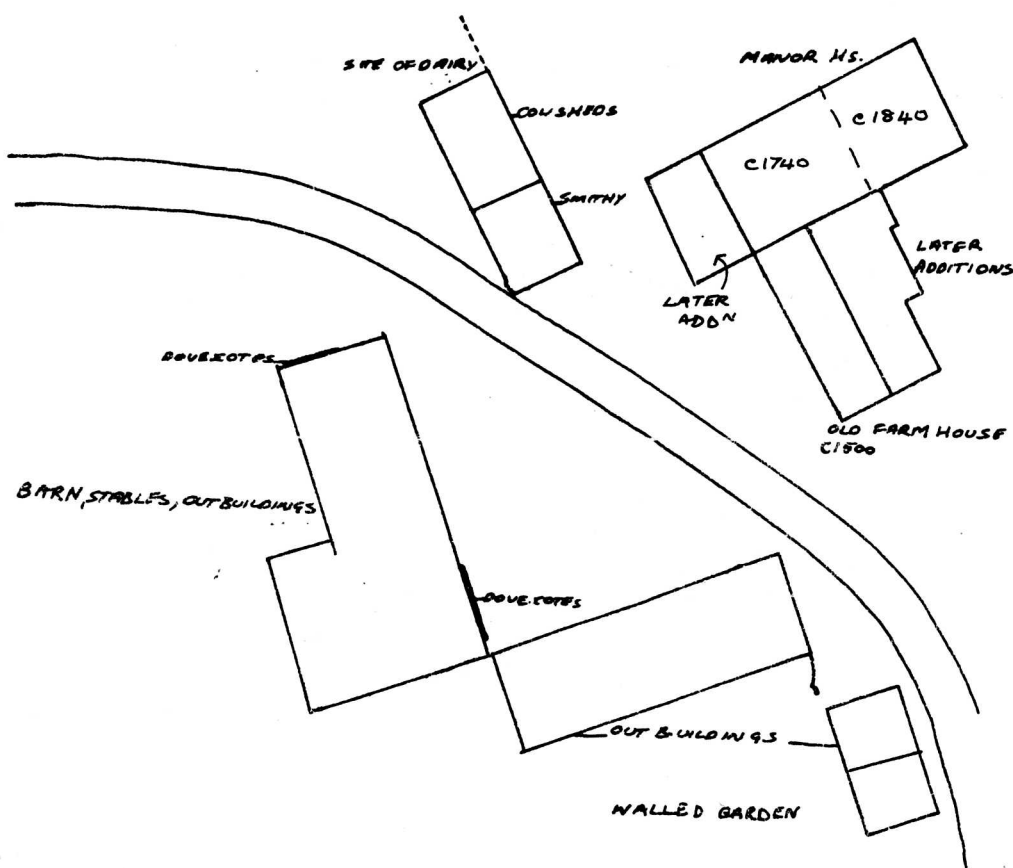
The outbuildings of the home farm comprise a Barn, Barn and Stables (with Dove Cotes), Dairy, Smithy, Cowshed (now demolished) plus others. The Dairy and Smithy have been converted into dwellings.

There is a Lodge; renovated ~1972.

There is also a circular raised garden and a walled garden. The fish ponds are not being maintained.
