The old home of the Warrens' is a typical county house of a pedigree family. William Warring (or Warren) the last of this family appearing in the Dale Castle MS., served as Sheriff in 1674. He was the 13th of his line, so giving 30 years for a generation we get back to the year 1284. The house is in excellent preservation, and was probably erected pretty early in the 17th century. The entrance is through a stone archway into a porch with stone seats on each side, then a very fine oak door with handsome iron-work hinges (inside bar holes) leads to the kitchen, which is a fine room with panelled roof; from the kitchen a door leads into the hall, a very fine room; on the left-hand side a handsome staircase leads to the sleeping apartments.
