Plaque:

Thomas Glyn Cothi (unitarian
preacher) born 1746 in this
dwelling. Therefore house must
predate Datestone 1781 found
in a wall. Plaque and
datestone in outer wall house.

Silin Evans, another preacher
also lived in this house. (Origin
of name?)

Last lived in ~1943.

The Kitchen has been used as a Shop 1917-1921; the present owner believes it was also used as a Chapel in the past. Later converted into 2 houses.

Mrs Bonny Capel fm.

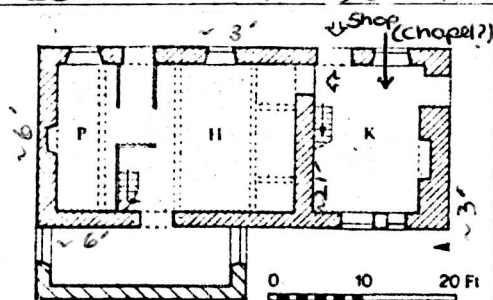
Started to fall down ~1960. Roof removed in 1982: Bracken and wheat thatch; cruck trusses.
