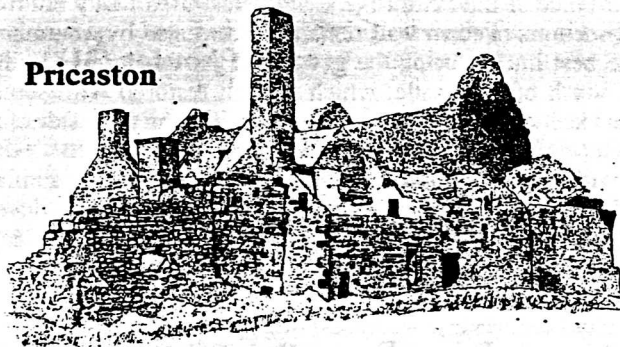



Hall, cross passage & service room incorporated in later rebuilding

important stone 16th hall with early 15th entrance front and additions within courtyard wall. Notable for its vaulting and screen passage with 3 fine stone arches (a rare survival). From c. 1600 - c. 1800 last family, as at Stackpole. On the army gunnery range, hence ruined.

Pricaston



Inaccessible on the Castlemartin Range lies the fine ruined group of buildings at **Pricaston (2)** the core of which is a great hall with a stone built three-door passage partition at one end. Nearby lay Linney, another early house that has now totally vanished except for some low  walling.
