John Higgon of Scolton was Sheriff in 1793; he was the only child of the Rector of Hubberston (Allen's Sheriffs). The Higgons were a very old Haverfordwest stock. The house was built by James Higgon the father of the Sheriff of 1889.

"Note - The old Mansion of Scolton was destroyed by ~~fire~~ lightning about two centuries ago, when the family went to reside in Haverfordwest, and remained there till 1841, when they returned to their old and newly restored family place."
