Reliquary of Alabaster

Somewhere hereabouts a reliquary was found, apparently of late 15th century work; it is in the form of an altar tomb with a recumbent female figure on the top. The reliquary is about 8 ins in length and 2½ in height and breadth. Arch. Camb. IV, i, 124 (illustrated)
