

An oval burial mound protruding from the slope between 167m - 183m contours.

The mound is about 1.5m high, approx 28m along its axis from N.E. to S.W. and approx 19m along its width from N.W. to S.E. There are traces of flanking ditches along the N.E. end, which have probably been filled in. The edges of the mound have been recently ploughed, exposing large kerb stones around the perimeter.

The ploughing has come to an abrupt halt on encountering this stonework which sharply delineates the present edge of the mound. It is not possible to say from surface observations whether this stonework represents an internal structure.

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
