

1) Discovered on the 12th September 1976 by D. Benson, whilst walking a pipe-line trench cut for Welsh Gas. This trench had been cut during the previous week and a large piece of timber c 2.50m long was lying on the side of the trench. Other pieces were subsequently found in the spoil heap. Only one piece of timber remained in situ in the East side of the trench, and this piece was excavated by D. Benson, T. James & D. Leighton on the 13th September.
