The "principal grange of the Lordship of Kemes", mentioned by the RCAHM, is identified by Rees as being a monastic site establishment. Its site is imprecisely located by the RCAHM, although the OS identify it as possibly being PRN 1609. However "the... grange of the Lordship" probably refers to a secular establishment... in this case Castell Nanhyfwr, PRN 1602, which was the centre of the Lordship until the C13, & thereafter would probably have remained in occupation as the "principal grange".		ly H.
