The chapelry of St. Mary is a plain edifice which has been "restored". The only object savouring of antiquity in it is the basin of the font, the pedestal being new. The front of the old basin bears a rough ornamentation. There are 18th century monuments in the church to the family of James of Gelly Fawr.
