

The Tithe Map & Apport ① records the names 'Park y Moat' and 'Park Moat Issa' roughly at SN234192. The OS from their RAF AP's ② record the 'cropmark of a small rectangular enclosure' in this area. From consultation with DAT RAF AP's ③, which unfortunately are partly obscured by cloud, and with DAT Meridian AP's ④, there is no trace of this rectangular cropmark.

These fields are known by the Lewis's ⑤ as 'Park Moat'. They are under pasture for cattle and were ploughed last year. They occupy a west facing slope and there is no trace of a 'moated homestead' nor of any other features of archaeological interest. Mr. Lewis pointed us in the direction of some lumps + bumps in his field - to the south of the ones bearing the 'Moat' element. He has not ploughed it in the 34 years that he has been in Lluwytreharne. However, these proved to be natural in origin.
