

Visited by H Williams, 19/4/77.

An oval mound, approx 10m long, standing adjacent to a hedge bank. ^{at SN 60341556} Originally a small stream ran round its outside (SW face) which has now been diverted through a cut along the line of the hedge (1). The mound very possibly results from the action of the stream, although the owner claims that stones in its makeup are not native to the area.

No trace of antiquity was found at SN 60331557 (2) & the feature described above is possibly that referred to by Cambell (3)
