

1638, remodelled & refronted 1780; 3 storey,

In 1839 a charity school (PRN 20487)
was set up in the grounds. It
closed in 1919

An inventory attached to the
will of William Gwynne dated
29 Mar 1680 mentions a brew house
and a milk house (dairy)
at the rear of the house.

"A deed dated 2nd June 1787
specifies the outbuildings as
follows: coach house malt
house, brew house, coalhouse,
wood house, cold bath house,
dovehouse, 'stables' etc"
