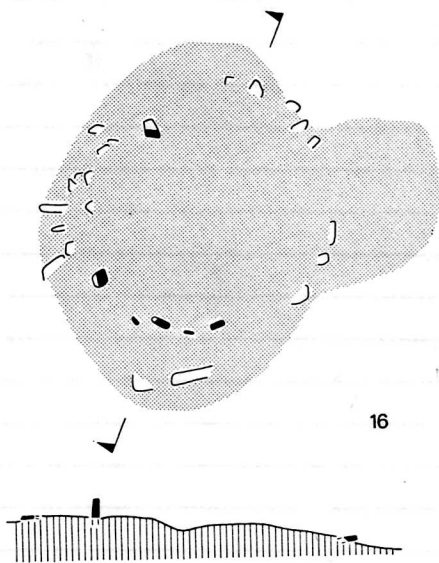


16. Carn Fflûr (fig. 8; surveyed 1981) SN 76 SW

7420 6245

Situated on a gently sloping platform on the N-facing slope of Carn Fflûr at c. 415 m OD. The cairn is a roughly oval mound of loose stones and boulders and measures 11.5 m (N-S) \times 9.5 m having a maximum height of 0.75 m. The shape of the mound has been distorted by the dumping of material on the E. Set within the cairn are the remains of a ring of slabs now mostly fallen outwards. In places there is a suggestion of concentricity. On the S the ring survives as an arc of orthostats, the tallest having a height of 0.6 m above the cairn. Towards the centre of the cairn there is a depression, but no evidence of a cist.
