70 No. 2 Butter Hill Manor House 8775

The Roch family have been established here for many generations.
Fenton saw a deed, temp. Eliz. in which it is termed THE GRANGE OF
BUTTER HILL; he supposed it may have belonged to Pill Priory. Here
(1897) is still preserved a spit turned by a dog wheel.

Roch family 1607-1906. Enlarged in
early 18th to 5 bays & 3 storeys with
full height stair in projecting bay. In
c. 1830 extended by two further bays
(on right) and remodelled inside all
rather plain, possibly by Owen of
Haverfordwest. An even bigger 4
storeys at the back. Outbuildings
dated 1842. Abandoned 1966, now
beyond repair. Shell grotto in grounds.
