

"Stone lined graves" reported from garden behind Salutation Inn. Noted circa 1978 during pipe laying, although existence apparently known to local authority beforehand. Was not reported to the Trust. "Headstone" preserved in nearby orchard (1). Medieval chapel documented in area (PRN 726).
